**INFORMATION TO BE NOTIFIED TO THE COMMITTEE WHERE
A SAFEGUARD INVESTIGATION IS TERMINATED
WITH NO SAFEGUARD MEASURE IMPOSED**

THAILAND

(Woven fabric)

The following communication, dated 10 September 2013, is being circulated at the request of the Delegation of Thailand.

In accordance with the formats for notifications adopted at the 6 May 1996 special meeting of the Committee on Safeguards for safeguard investigations that are terminated without imposing safeguard measures (document G/SG/2, 1 July 1996), the Government of Thailand hereby provides notification regarding the termination of a safeguard investigation concerning woven fabrics.

1. Specify the product subject to investigation

The product concerned is woven fabric currently falling under the Thai Customs Tariff Codes 5208 and 5513.

2. Identify the WTO document containing the notification of initiation

G/SG/N/6/THA/3 published on 17 December 2012. The investigation was initiated by the means of a Notice of Initiation published in the Royal Gazette on 7 December B.E. 2555 (2012).

3. Specify the date on which the investigation was terminated

The investigation was terminated on 31 August B.E. 2556 (2013), the day following the publication of the Notification of the Committee on Safeguard Measures of Thailand in the Royal Gazette.

4. Identify the reason(s) for termination

A major proportion of the domestic industry was not established according to Section 3 of The Safeguard Measures on Increased Imports Act B.E. 2550 (2007).

5. Provide the reference for the published notice of termination

The Notification of the Committee on Safeguard Measures of Thailand published in the Royal Gazette on 30 August B.E. 2556 (2013).

6. Provide any other information that the notifying Member may consider relevant
