**Re: Anti-Dumping investigation concerning the extension of the anti-dumping duty on the importation of low voltage copper cables from Turkey - final findings**

According to section 32.28(c)(1)(2) and (3) of the Israeli Trade Levies and Safeguard Measures Law, 1991 (the "**Law**"), I have submitted the final findings of the above investigation to the Advisory Committee for Anti-Dumping and Countervailing Duty (the "**Committee**").
